#### 春に予定されているコミュニティガーデンの拡張計画

メープルトン市議会は、リバーサイドパークにあるコミュニティガーデンの拡張提案を承認しました。今回の拡張により、庭の面積は50%増加し、より多くの住民が野菜や花を育てるための区画を予約できるようになります。この決定は、最近の調査で、現在のスペースの利用を希望する住民が約 200人の待機リストに載っていることが判明したことを受けたものです。
